HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE CONGREGATIONAL CONVERSATION:

After the congregation-led service on Sunday, October 18th, our first gathering of 2020 was held, facilitated by Bill Lee. The first topic of conversation for our church was the idea to bring the internet into Kinmount United. A good discussion took place weighing the pros and the cons of such an endeavour. The cost quoted from Solve-All was \$45.00/month. Internet connection could compliment our 'in-person' services and enhance the music component for our services. The group's consensus was to proceed with this item. (Update: Copyright implications must be investigated before moving forward)

The second topic discussed was communion. There were two possible dates left in 2020 for a communion service with Rev. David Watson, November 8th and December 13th. Bill was to contact David to see if he could do communion on Sunday, December 13th. Due to our Covid-19 protocols, our group agreed to a "BYOE" (Bring Your Own Elements) format for this communion. (Update: Communion will be Sunday, December 13th)

The third topic for discussion was closing the church again for January and February. After looking at the calendar for 2021 and the date for Easter, there was agreement amongst our group to close Kinmount United for the months of January and February and the first two Sundays in March. This means that the last service of 2020 will be on Sunday, December 20th (Christmas carol service) and the first service of 2021 will be on Sunday, March 21st. It was noted that Palm Sunday is March 28th and Easter Sunday is April 4th.

Matt Dunn spoke on the topic of church insurance. Our insurance comes due early next year and Matt wanted everyone to think about what to do if some disaster struck Kinmount United (fire, tornado). The people present felt that a 'rebuild' of KUC would not be the same. The possible direction would be to have our insurance policy pay for the clean-up after a disaster but not for a rebuild. Again, this is to be finalized in early 2021.

Rev. Leslie King added that our church archives (which Leslie sorted and organized earlier) should be protected, again in case of a catastrophe at KUC. Leslie was going to email Bill with the contact information at the UCC. (Update: Bill now has the contact info)
